
#### **HARMONY** - Voice leading

- How each voice moves from one chord to another
- Good voice leading: lead each voice to the closest note
- Be aware of voice leading all the time

#### Example - No Voice leading




















### LESSON 7 NOTES

#### **MELODY - FILL IN (Part 2)**

- Connecting 2 chord tones
- The concept of Tension & Resolution
- Stable notes: Root (1st), 3rd, and 5th of the chord
- Tension notes: 2nd, 4th, 6th, and 7th of the chord

Fill in: Stable (chord tone) → Tension (non-chord tone) → Resolution (chord tone)


### Tension & Resolution in a C major chord (C major key)

- 3. Repeating idea






# LESSON 8 NOTES

#### **RANGE & REGISTER**

- Range: how far apart the notes are / 有幾闊
- Register: how high or low the notes are / 高低音

#### Range & Effects

- Low Mid-Low Mid Mid-High High
- C1-C8 on piano



#### **General Principle**

- Lower: Stronger, Darker
- Higher: Lighter, Brighter

#### **Voicing Principle**

• The farther out you go, the further your notes have to be


#### PIANO ARRANGEMENT

• use elements of Melody, Harmony, and Rhythm to create different dynamic levels and a story line

#### **Dynamic levels**

- Rhythm: Long < Half Time < Pop Ballad < 147 < Drive 8
- Melody: No fill-ins > Add fill-ins
- Harmony Range & Register: High < Mid-High < Mid < Mid-Low < Low

#### Sample Music chart



#### **General Principles**

- Space out dynamics with one change at a time on rhythm/ range
- Discipline not to start off too much
